

High School Building Committee July 2010 – Update

The High School Building Committee has been busy since the June Town Meeting. Since then the committee has been working with the MSBA on the documents needed to move forward with the Feasibility Study. The process since June is in essence the legal requirements and agreements between the Town and the MSBA to move forward with the study. This study requires a number of different activities by the town which when completed will result as the basis moving forward for the entire project.

Issues such as the Feasibility Study itself, the completion of the documents required to partner with the MSBA for funding and coordination of projects, selection of the Owners Project Manager (OPM) Designer and Environmental Site Testing are all requirements of the Feasibility Study. Also included is the funding agreement between the Town and the MSBA. These issues must be agreed upon prior to moving forward with the project and we anticipate these agreements to be finalized within approximately the next few weeks. Upon completion of these documents the Town will go out to bid for the next step of the process such as the OPM, Designer etc.

Many community members have contacted the committee offering to help. We appreciate the enthusiasm and interest as we travel this road. Shortly, once the Feasibility Study and other activities are in full swing, the committee will need the help and input from the community. The HSBC committed to involving the community in this process and we value your suggestions and ideas.
