

June 2011 Update

Beginning in June, the School Building Committee will be meeting monthly. Please check for [dates](#) on this website. Meetings will be held as usual, at 7 pm in the High School Library.

In preparation for the groundbreaking, a “walk through” of the outside of the high school was held. The group determined what could be kept, what could be donated, and what needed to be discarded. There are a number of memorial markers on the site and it is important to safeguard them until the new building is completed. The DPW will assist in moving some of these items to a safe area until they can be relocated once the new school is built. Soon, the committee will be contacting various town groups to determine if they are interested in accepting and removing some of the items, such as outdoor lighting and goal posts. The Garden Club has also agreed to evaluate the plants and will remove those that they can use. The SBC greatly appreciates the cooperation of these groups in helping with the task of clearing the area and finding a new home for many of the items.

Recently, the MSBA requested that a geotechnical peer review be conducted. The peer review is an added safeguard to assure that the design solution chosen is the correct one for the particular soil conditions at the East Bridgewater site.
