

## **September 2013 update**

East Bridgewater Junior/Senior High School opened its doors for the first day of school on August 29, 2013. Many students, parents and residents took advantage of the opportunity to tour the inside of the building on August 20-22. The tours were extremely popular, with each day bringing even more people than the day before. The well-equipped new classrooms and large rooms (gymnasium, auditorium, library, cafeteria and lecture hall) “wowed” visitors who had been waiting a long time to see the new school.

Though the occupancy permits for the school building have been granted, there is still much to do outside in the fields. The work of demolishing the old high school will begin soon but it will take months to complete. That site will eventually be used for a strip of parking as well as baseball and soccer fields.
